1st Stop – **Château d'Amboise**

A royal residence with a panoramic view over the Loire.

The castle is located in Amboise, on the banks of the Loire River, France. It was built in the 15th–16th centuries and was an important residence of French kings during the Renaissance.

The castle flourished especially during the reigns of Charles VIII of France and Francis I of France. The Chapel of Saint Hubert is located here, where Leonardo da Vinci is buried.

From the castle terraces, there is a beautiful view over the Loire Valley. It is one of the most remarkable historical castles in the Loire Valley.

Château du Clos Lucé

~13:00–14:00 Castle visit

It is best known as the place where Leonardo da Vinci spent the last three years of his life (1516–1519), following the invitation of King Francis I of France.

The castle was built in the 15th century and is connected to Amboise Castle by an underground passage. Today, it houses a museum displaying models of Leonardo's inventions, his workshop, and Renaissance interiors. Surrounding the castle is a large park with an open-air exhibition of mechanisms and inventions.

 Clos Lucé – Leonardo da Vinci's last residence

It is one of the most popular Renaissance attractions in the Loire Valley.

2nd Stop – Château de Chenonceau

The famous "Ladies' Castle" above the River Cher
Renaissance interiors
French gardens

The castle is located in the Loire Valley, near Chenonceaux, France. It was built in the 16th century and is one of the most beautiful Renaissance castles in France.

The castle is unique because it is built across the River Cher – its gallery stretches directly over the water. Chenonceau is often called the "Ladies' Castle" because women such as Diane de Poitiers and Catherine de' Medici played an important role in its development.

Today, the castle is a popular tourist attraction with luxurious interiors and beautiful gardens.

Important information:

Cancellation policy (organizer's side):

If the client does not arrive at the excursion at the specified time and place, the paid amount will not be refunded.

Cancellation policy (client's side):

If the client cancels the reservation no later than 48 hours before the start of the excursion, the organizer refunds 95% of the paid amount, withholding 5% to cover administrative expenses.

If the client cancels later than 48 hours before the start of the excursion, the organizer reserves the right not to refund the paid amount.
